SUMMER PAID SERVICE OPPORTUNITY

Are you interested in improving life with youth,
serving your community, and launching your career?

Consider sharing your summer with AmeriCorps starting in June 2019

Two positions are available, one serving in LCEC high school Youth Action Summer Internship, a leadership, organizing, and career development internship for 10–12 youth and the other supporting our middle school summer camp and focused employment readiness program. We emphasize positive youth development, racial/social justice, and trauma informed approaches to work with a diverse and dynamic group of young people through academic, health and fitness, arts and creativity, and community service work.

These PASS positions offer members a direct service experience with on-site supervisory support plus the chance to explore career interests and build a resume while changing the life of youth. Employers are taking notice of AmeriCorps, with many joining the Employers of National Service initiative—a concerted effort to connect AmeriCorps alumni to employers who understand the value alumni bring to their organization. <http://www.nationalservice.gov/special-initiatives/employers-national-service>

Calendar/Schedule: AmeriCorps term runs June 10–August 31, 2019
11am–5pm Monday–Thursday
9am–5pm Friday
Week-long trip to Washington DC with youth interns (late July or early August)

Compensation: Members receive a living allowance of \$2520 (\$420 bi-weekly, pre-tax); are able to put qualified student loans in forbearance; may apply for the WI FoodShare program (eligibility determined by the State); and receive gear and an education award of \$1,252.91 upon successful completion of the term.

Requirements: 300 hours between June 10 and August 31, 2019. Applicants must be 17 years of age or older, U.S. citizen or permanent resident, have a high school diploma or GED, and pass a criminal background check.
